

Camp A Cappella Packing List

some items necessities, some optional

WE PROVIDE:

- Sheets, blanket, pillow, towel, washcloth
- Camp A Cappella T-Shirt
- Camp A Cappella water bottle
- Folder with music/schedule/pencil

YOU SHOULD PACK:

- Clothing for 5 days
 - Keep in mind that we will be both inside and outside (weather providing)
 - Black pants (slacks or jeans) or skirt for the final performance, with a black collared shirt or top. For the large ensemble performance, singers will wear their Camp A Cappella T-Shirts.
 - Running shoes/sneakers or other close-toed shoes are mandatory for choreography rehearsal (rather than flip-flops), and black shoes for the final show
 - Minors: standard school dress code applies in terms of decency
- Toiletries (toothbrush, shampoo, soap, etc)
- Shower shoes/flip-flops for shower if desired - optional
- Sport equipment for outdoor time (frisbee, football, hackey sack, etc) – optional
- Pitch pipe/metronome/mini keyboard – optional
- Laptop/ipad – optional: with...
 - notation software (Finale, Sibelius, Noteflight (free and web-based) and copies of arrangements (if you arrange/songwrite or plan to learn)
 - audio or video editing software (if you wish to play with concepts from recording or video production class)
- Notebook & paper or electronic device for taking notes in class – optional
- Recorder or recorder app on phone for recording parts in rehearsal – optional
- Cards/games/books for free time – optional
- Any personal medications needed (let us know if you want Camp A Cappella staff to hold them)
- Small umbrella or rain poncho – there is a 5-10 minute walk between various points on campus, so use your own judgment on how you wish to stay dry should it rain.
- Bathing suits - we are working on securing access to the Wright State Rec Center pool (of course, WSU has first priority).

PLEASE NOTE:

- ***Campers who bring or use any illicit or illegal substances (drugs, alcohol, weapons) will be immediately expelled with no refund and will be sent home at your expense. Authorities will be called when required. This includes tobacco/vape use if the camper is not legally of age.***
- Wright State University has free and open WiFi, subject to the standard “no illicit web use allowed” policy
- Camp A Cappella will have an emergency MED KIT with items such as band-aids, ibuprofen, pepto-bismol, etc. A log will be kept of anything dispensed. PARENTS: if you do not want your child to access the med kit, please notify us by emailing info@campacappella.com.
- Please do not bring perfumes, cologne, or heavily scented lotions. Other campers could have reactions to such things. Just stay clean and use standard deodorant/anti-perspirants.
